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RED Express - Methodology

- 1,000 interviews conducted by phone using a random digit dial sample to ensure all households including ex-directory numbers are covered.
- Half of the sample of 1,000 adults are reached using a RDD (random digit dial) landline sample with the other half now conducted using an RDD mobile phone sample. Data is then weighted to known demographic and phone type data.
- Thus the total sample gives a margin of error of +/- 3.2%
- Quotas set and final data weighted to ensure that the sample is randomly representative of the total Irish population aged 18+.
- Fieldwork conducted between the 29th Nov and 1st Dec 2010
